Carol is dating the captain of the Vipers! She must have wanted to make sure her boyfriend won the match!

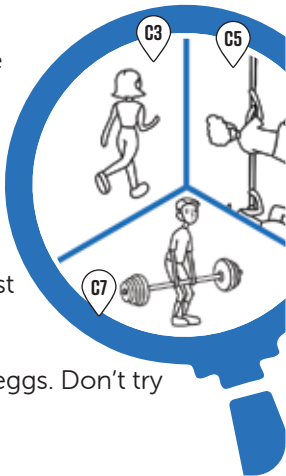


**TIME FOR A TRAINING MONTAGE!
