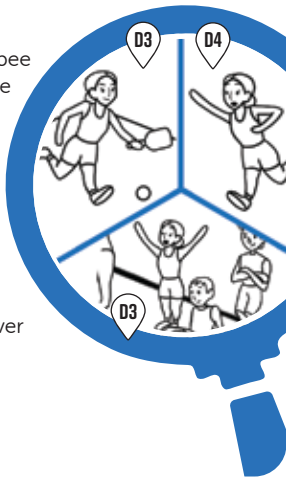


**WHAT THREE THINGS DID
